



PARTICIPANT CODE OF CONDUCT

As a member of *Ashgrove Calisthenics Club* ("the Club") you are required to meet the following requirements in regards to your conduct during any activity held or sanctioned by the Club, Calisthenics Victoria ("CV") as a member of the State Association or affiliated club, in your role as a participant.

The **Code of Conduct** outlines acceptable conduct:

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants, coaches, officials, parents and spectators regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
2. Be honest with your Coach concerning illness, injury and your ability to train fully within class or competition requirements; show concern and caution towards others who may be ill or injured.
3. Focus on your performance rather than winning or losing and never ridicule a fellow participant for making a mistake. Show appreciation for good performance by fellow team members and competing teams.
4. Co-operate with coaching staff at class and competitions and work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
5. Arrive at class, competitions and specified Club functions punctually.
6. Care and respect the equipment provided to you by the Club.
7. Wear the requested attire to classes, competitions and nominated Club functions.
8. Refrain from using your mobile phone during class time.
9. Maintain high personal behaviour standards at all times and be a positive role model.
10. Conduct yourself in a professional manner relating to language; inappropriate language or conversation topics at class, competitions or nominated Club functions is unacceptable. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially with or in the vicinity of persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are an example.
11. Do not physically or verbally abuse or harass anyone associated within the sport of calisthenics (participant, coach, adjudicator, parent and so on).

13. Abide by Calisthenics Victoria's Alcohol & Other Drugs policy
14. Abide by Calisthenics Victoria's Communications & Social Media policy

16. Understand the repercussions if you breach, or are aware of any breaches of this code of conduct.
